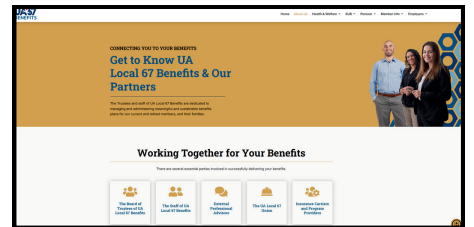
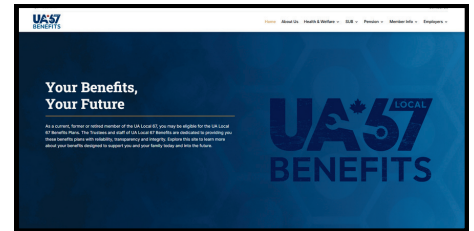
A message from the Board of Trustees
